The average age of men in the ATP Top-100 at the end of 2013 was 27.5 years.

In 2013 there were seven men who broke into the Top-100 for the first time (names underlined in red in the above table).

Their average age when they reached the Top-100 was 22.7 years; the youngest being Jiri Vesely who entered the Top-100 age 19.
